- 1. Open Forum:** No concerns were raised
- 2. Apologies for absence:** None
- 3. Declarations of member's interests in any items on this agenda:** None
- 4. Planning – To discuss planning application DC/23/1288/LBC – Listed Building Consent –** alterations include replacing some windows, an improved connection between kitchen and formal dining room, reconfiguration of some of the first and second floor bathroom/bedrooms and re-arranging the flat roof 1950's extension at Cedar Court, Hollesley Road, IP12 3BB. – The chairman reported that he had been unable to gain access to the interior of the property as although contractors are working there the owners were not present, but from looking at the plans there appears to be nothing controversial. NR stated that he had studied the plans and found them to be acceptable and in his opinion the replacement windows would be an improvement. APC has no objections to these plans.
- 5. Coronation Celebrations – to finalise arrangements –** It was confirmed that there will be a Coronation Bake-Off followed by a Royal Quiz in The Swan Inn on Saturday 6 May. The Parish Council has organised a Bring your own Picnic with free tea and cake from 2 – 4p.m on Sunday 7 May at the recreation ground with music and children's activities. Commemorative bone china Coronation mugs will be presented to all resident children under the age of 16 at this event. Any surplus mugs will be available for sale at £10 each. This will be followed by a BBQ to be held at The Swan Inn at 6p.m.
- 6. Pavilion – To inspect and decide what repairs are required –** Councillors spent some time inspecting the outside of the pavilion. It was decided that JH and MW would meet on site with Kevin Foreman to do an inspection and give an up to date estimate for emergency work required. One of the outside posts should be replaced immediately.
- 7. Matters to be brought to the attention of the council –** MW stated that he would look into painting a line around the area on the basketball base which has been laid with permeable tarmac to signify a shooting area.
